Why Wilson works

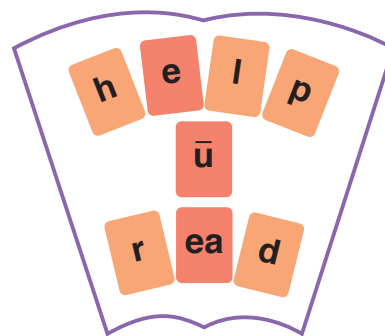

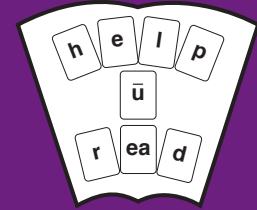
